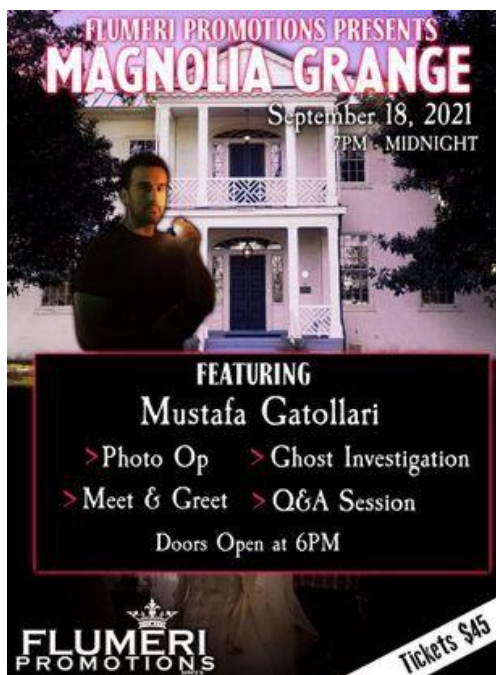

office and were instrumental in dictating the county's political development. The name Magnolia Grange derives from a circle of magnolia trees and formal boxwood gardens that once graced the lawn, destroyed after the Civil War to cultivate further farmland.

The house was built by William Winfree in 1823 and stayed in the family until 1845. Winfree was descended from an early Chesterfield County family. After the house passed out of the Winfree family, it was sold to a succession of owners. Several of Magnolia's owners faced financial difficulties and had to sell the property soon after buying it. The house retains virtually all of its ornate woodwork; most significant are elaborate ceiling medallions and the Federal mantels with slender Ionic columns supporting an embellished entablature and deeply molded cornice.

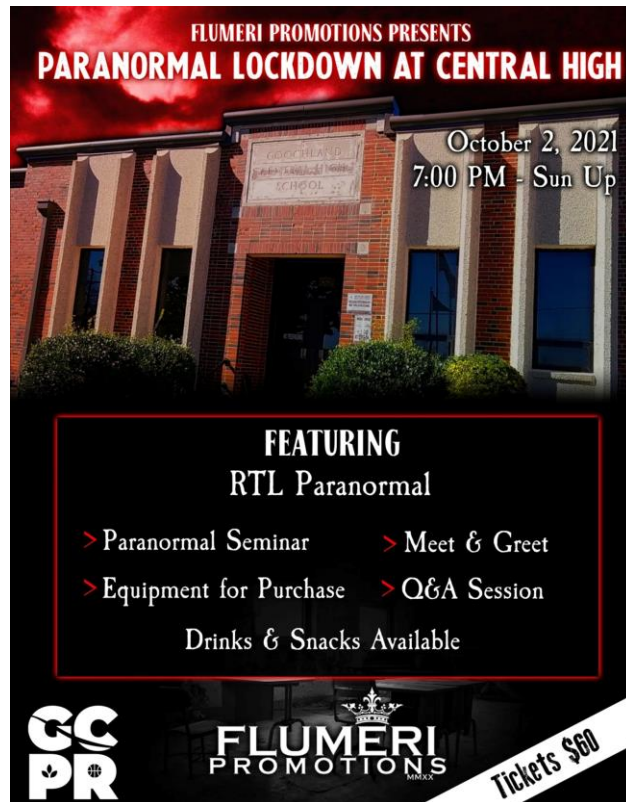

When I found out Tuesday that **Christopher Sutton** passed away, it brought back a lot of emotions and memories of what it was like watching my father go through with adenocarcinoma that I crammed inside for a long time. Watching him take tons of meds, the chemotherapy, the



In 1845, Thomas Ritch erected the Ritch's Hotel on Main St. in Napanoch, NY for those who wanted to escape the city life. Due to the convenience of the nearby railroad, may travelers frequent the hotel. *In* 1851, Ritch sold the hotel where it became known as the Hungerford's Hotel. Mr. Hungerford catered to the same clientele as Mr. Ritch, including the elite Gentleman's Club that boasted a very distinguished membership and was quick to dandle the ladies of the bordello on their knees. The hotel changed hands a few times but in 1887, Adolph Wagner became the new landlord. Eight years later, on March 18, 1895, a nearby home in Napanoch caught fire. The fire quickly spread leaving ruin in its wake. The Shanley Hotel was not spared the damage and was tragically burned to the ground. Mr. Wagner would not see his investment go to waste so he quickly rebuilt and the hotel was back in business by November of the same year. The most notable owner and for whom the hotel is still named was James Shanley. When his family immigrated to New York City from Ireland, James and his brothers found success in

immunotherapy and all the pain he went through. I felt helpless, pain, depression, and anger. I was there with my family when he got diagnosed at Georgetown University Hospital, taking time off from work each time he or family called when it got really bad just so I could be there, to the day before he passed when he felt like he kicked cancer's ass, all the way to the last time I kissed him and held his hand on his deathbed at the hospice room. All those feelings came back two days ago when I heard the news. I fell into a wormhole. All those feelings came rushing back. When I first talked to Chris about being with Flumeri Promotions, I instantly fell in love with the guy. The man loved everyone and everything about our community that we call the paranormal field. The first event I ever did with him was the Shanley Hotel in New York. I watched in awe as I watched him infect the guests that night with his loving

opening restaurants and hotels across the country. He moved upstate and discovered the beauty of the hotel and the town of Napanoch. He purchased the hotel for his own on October 1, 1906. Mr. Shanley gave it his own touch by adding a bowling alley, billiard room and even a barber shop to the building. James's success brought prestige to the community but it wasn't simply his ability to produce revenue that made the people of Napanoch love him. He was a good man with a kind heart and an outgoing personality; people naturally were drawn to him, including the lovely Beatrice Rowley. The two were married at the Shanley Hotel on April 26, 1910 and took off to the Nation's Capital to enjoy their honeymoon. When the newlyweds returned from Washington D.C., they were met by a parade welcoming them home. It was a grand celebration that night that would signal a grand future for the young couple, that is, until tragedy after tragedy befell the family. Unfortunately, tragedy struck the couple. Beatrice loved children and dreamed of having a large family with her beloved James. On January 6, 1912, she gave birth to their first daughter, Kathleen. The poor soul only lived a little shy of six months. She would go on to give birth to two more children, James Shanley, Jr who lived four and a half months and William Shanley who died at a little over nine months. Her broken heart can still *be felt within* the walls of the Haunted Shanley Hotel. There is more to the story that is the Shanley Hotel that you will get to hear about that night. Your guest investigator for the night is none other than Daryl Marston from the television show Ghost Hunters! Daryl is a seasoned paranormal investigator and is the co-owner of Paranormal Warehouse. Windsor Castle, Smithfield, VA



The Norfolk Masonic Temple is a majestic 78,000 square foot building which the fraternal home to eight Masonic lodges, three Masonic related appendant bodies as well as two active appendant organizations. The most iconic building in Norfolk, VA has seen its share of tragedy. Years ago, one of the head Deacons, The Honorable Judge Fentress died of a heart attack during a Mason ceremony. Another incident occurred when someone was accidentally locked inside the Masonic Temple after the the superintendent locked up for the weekend. Trying to find a way out, he discovered a metal ladder to and upper walk space. Realizing there was no way out, he climbed back down the ladder. He lost his balance and fell the rest of the way down, breaking his neck and dying at the bottom of the ladder. He was not found until days later when the superintendent came back to open the Temple. Local paranormal group RTL PARANORMAL has investigated the building many times and have captured things they cannot explain. Loud noises, sounds of footsteps, EVPs (electronic voice phenomena), spirit box communication. Not only will you have the opportunity to ghost hunt this magnificent building with RTL PARANORMAL, but you will be ghost hunting with none

As the Santa Fe, Gulf, and Colorado Railroads merged in West Texas and the railroad expanded from Brownwood, it took many casualties such as Runnels City and unlawful cowboys. In 1886, the town of Hutchins, formally known as Gresham, renamed its town Ballinger after receiving

donations from its benefactor, Judge William Pitt Ballinger. It was on June 29, 1886 that the town formally gathered to sell lots and incorporated with approximately 3000 people in its population.

The town was known for its commerce, cotton production, railroads, saloons and outlaws. The area has a rich history to include gun battles and ghost stories. One of the reasons for this is the numerous locations that are claimed to be haunted. Along with houses in Ballinger and other business locations, The Olde Park Hotel remains a hot spot for paranormal activity.

The hotel was originally a meeting house, boarding house, school house, restaurant, music store, brothel, and antique store. It was also previously the Secrest Hotel, The Three Sisters Hotel, The Royal Hotel, and also the Park Hotel. When the park complex in front of the hotel was annexed, it was renamed the the Olde Park complex, which ultimately led to the change in name to the Olde Park Hotel in the 1920's by the previous owner. The original fence that bordered the courthouse park was moved and now encircle the evergreen cemetery just outside of town.

Owners such as Washington Hampton Secrest II, The Keel Family and numerous others have left their mark on the hotel as some of the rooms are still named after them to honor their history of ownership. Their pictures can be found in the museum downstairs in the hotel along with a gift shop for souvenirs.

Many people in Ballinger, TX or who have visited Olde Park Hotel believed the hotel to be haunted! Those who have ghost hunted OPH have experienced seeing many apparitions. From apparitions of cowboys, to the "ladies of the night" who worked in the bordello, to little children, to shadow people, to even a woman dressed in red, black and white clothing! People have heard disembodied voices, loud knocks, the phantom smells of perfume and cigars and sounds of boots walking down the hallways!

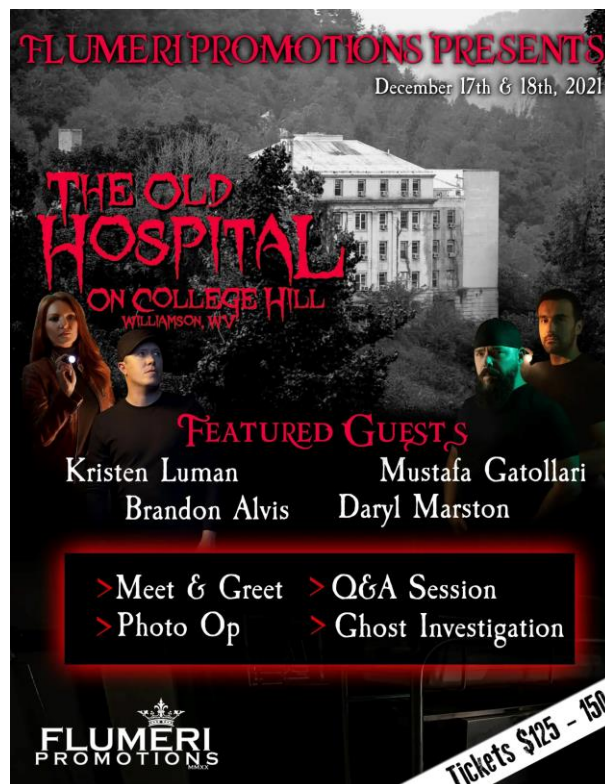
