The Norfolk Masonic Temple is a majestic 78,000 square foot building which is the fraternal home to eight Masonic lodges, three Masonic related appendant bodies as well as two active appendant organizations. The most iconic building in Norfolk, VA has seen its share of tragedy. Years ago, one of the head Deacons, The Honorable Judge Fentress died of a heart attack during a Mason ceremony. Another incident occurred when someone was accidentally locked inside the Masonic Temple after the superintendent locked up for the weekend. Trying to find a way out, he discovered a metal ladder to an upper walk space. Realizing there was no way out, he climbed back down the ladder. He lost his balance and fell the rest of the way down, breaking his neck and dying at the bottom of the ladder. He was not found until days later when the superintendent came back to open the Temple. Local paranormal group RTL PARANORMAL has investigated the building many times and have captured things they cannot explain. Loud noises, sounds

When I found out Tuesday that [Christopher Sutton](#) passed away, it brought back a lot of emotions and memories of what it was like watching my father go through with adenocarcinoma that I crammed inside for a long time. Watching him take tons of meds, the chemotherapy, the immunotherapy and all the pain he went

renamed its town Ballinger after receiving donations from its benefactor, Judge William Pitt Ballinger. It was on June 29, 1886 that the town formally gathered to sell lots and incorporated with approximately 3000 people in its population.

The town was known for its commerce, cotton production, railroads, saloons and outlaws. The area has a rich history to include gun battles and ghost stories. One of the reasons for this is the numerous locations that are claimed to be haunted. Along with houses in Ballinger and other business locations, The Olde Park Hotel remains a hot spot for paranormal activity.

The hotel was originally a meeting house, boarding house, school house, restaurant, music store, brothel, and antique store. It was also previously the Secrest Hotel, The Three Sisters Hotel, The Royal Hotel, and also the Park Hotel. When the park complex in front of the hotel was annexed, it was renamed the Olde Park complex, which ultimately led to the change in name to the Olde Park Hotel in the 1920's by the previous owner. The original fence that bordered the courthouse park was moved and now encircles the evergreen cemetery just outside of town.

Owners such as Washington Hampton Secrest II, The Keel Family and numerous others have left their mark on the hotel as some of the rooms are still named after them to honor their history of ownership. Their pictures can be found in the museum downstairs in the hotel along with a gift shop for souvenirs.

Many people in Ballinger, TX or who have visited Olde Park Hotel believed the hotel to be haunted! Those who have ghost hunted OPH have experienced seeing many apparitions. From apparitions of cowboys, to the "ladies of the night" who worked in the bordello, to little children, to shadow people, to even a woman dressed in red, black and white clothing! People have heard disembodied voices, loud knocks, the phantom smells of perfume and cigars and sounds of boots walking down the hallways!





The Grand Victorian Inn is a beautiful location rich in history and sits surrounded by Nature's amazing scenery. The Grand Victorian Inn dates back to 1885, when it was owned by the Renfro family and was used as a hotel for Mammoth Cave tourists. Back then, tourists would come in on the railroad, which sits right in front of the bed and breakfast, and take stagecoaches to Mammoth Cave. History of The Mentz Hotel stretches back to just after The War Between the States. Mr. Mentz was the train station master for Mammoth Cave Railroad Co. from 1853, taking visitors to Mammoth Cave on four passenger cars. In 1885 Mr. Mentz and Mr. Renfro created The Mentz Hotel which unfortunately burned down in 1903. In 1905, the Renfro Hotel became the Mentz Hotel and then later on it became the Fishback Hotel. From 1946 to 1952, the building became the Baulch Junior School for Boys and then was home to a nursing home for six years before it became a private home. The Carroll's bought The Grand Victorian Inn in 2015 and have lovingly restored back it back to its glory days! Beside the Grand Victorian is Bell's Tavern ruins. Revolutionary war veteran Colonel William Bell built an inn beside the highway. It grew into the 19th century "Bell's Tavern". The inn became a hotspot for the shabby the well-heeled alike. Built during the mid-19th century, the tavern was gutted by fire just prior to the Civil War. Though the family intended rebuild it out of stone, the outbreak of war prevented them from completing the project. Today, massive stone walls and arched windows are overgrown with ivy.

John McInteer was born in Ireland and as a young unsupervised boy in 1827, he traveled to the United States. He settled first in Philadelphia and then Indiana, where he learned the trade of harness making. Hearing of the opportunities existing in the west, he moved to Kansas in the early 1860s. First setting up home in Doniphan County, John McInteer started a small shop in Atchison where he manufactured harnesses and saddles. His product became known for their

workmanship and he did a great amount of business wagon trains plying the Overland Trails. His Business was so successful that he had to enlarge his facilities and manufacture his product on a large scale. The wealth he accumulated from his business was invested into real estate in Atchison and nearby St. Joseph, MO. He also erected number of business blocks in Atchison. The McInTeer Villa is one of Atchison's most unique residencies. Built in 1889-1890 for business pioneer John McInTeer the impressive brick residence was constructed at an estimated cost of \$14,000. The architect has not been identified. However, the builder was Owen E. Seip, a long time Atchison contractor. Mr. McInTeer first wife Alice, died in 1892. He married his second wife, Anna Conlon, a widow with three sons in 1895. After Mr. McInTeer's death in 1902, Anna continued living in the home until her death in 1916. During her ownership, the house was home to large numbers of the Conlon relatives which included many children. From 1916-1925 her brother Judge Charles J. Conlon, a prominent lawyer and his family made it their home. For the next twenty-five years it was a rooming house and then in 1952, the McInTeer Villa was purchased by Ms. Isobel Altus, a retired professional violinist and eccentric according to her Atchison neighbors. She lacked the financial resources to follow through on her desire to restore the house and in 1969, shortly before her death sold it George Gerady who had started to rehabilitate it. The McInTeer Villa is still one of the most unusual and picturesque houses built in Atchison today.

THE PARANORMAL CLAIMS:

Many have seen lights turning on and off in the tower.... there is no electricity up there. People have seen figures in the windows when no one was home. A speaker was thrown off the counter and boxes have been seen to move. The rocking chair that "Goldie" died in has been known to rock back and forth on its own. Sounds of slamming doors throughout the night. Footstep walking down the hallway on the second floor have been heard throughout the night. Some feel uneasy on the second floor, as if they are being watched. Items tend to move from one location to another, doorknobs creaking, lights turning on and off, and dramatic temperature fluctuations. Female and Male disembodied voices, shadow people have also been seen, and phantom smells of cigarettes and women's perfume can be smelled throughout the home. And nine

documented deaths (natural deaths) and one suicide (Charles Donovan 10-10-1922) are documented to have occurred at the 1889 McInteer Villa.
