

## About this event

**The Clifton 5 Theater was built in 1883 by Joseph Watson and Frank Heffright and was originally called The Opera House. The Opera House had a seating capacity of 1,500 and boasted plays of thrilling melodramas to wild west actions. Known as "Opera Block", the Opera House took up almost the entire block. Businesses made up the first floor and the auditorium was on the second, while the gallery took place on the third floor. Two wide flights of stairs were erected off the main entrance. Ironically, stairs such as those were no longer used in other buildings, because loss of lives in fires across the country made these types of staircases obsolete. A great depression swept the United States in the middle of the 1890s and it caused people to look into things with a more trained eye for fear of losing businesses to fire. So, insurance rates took a huge spike and in February of 1895, the board of trustees announced that the theater will do no more**

shows and the sets will be removed to make way for a Y.M.C.A. The theater sadly burned down in 1901. Although no lives were lost because of the fire, no one is sure what caused the fire. Some say it was three youths who caused the fires. While others attribute it to faulty wiring, defective flues, or possibly an overheated stove in one of the dressing rooms. The theater was bought and rebuilt in 1916 by Andy Gamble. Andy thought that "talkies" were more important to show rather than live theater, because it was cheaper and more profitable. Unfortunately, another fire hit the theater in 1920. Resulting in Andy to sell the building in 1921. Robert Blackford was the next owner, and he changed the name to Clifton after his son Clifton who at the time was serving in the Army. Mr. Blackford owned the Clifton for many years and became quite successful in making the theater profitable. Jim Kalos was the next owner of Clifton Theater and many interesting things happened under his ownership. A bomb threat was made on the theater but turned out to be a prank. When the movie *Night of the Living Dead* premiered, so many people rioted the movie that Kalos had to call in the police, because the rioters were shaking the ticket booth! Once again, the theater was to face another tragedy.... The Great Flood of 1972. The flood completely submerged Theater #2! David People bought the building in the mid-1970s and added theaters 4 & 5 and renamed it Clifton % for its 5 theaters.

#### PARANORMAL CLAIMS:

- In the lobby area a lady in red has been seen walking up the staircase as well as, disembodied voices and the feelings of being touched.
- It is rumored to be said that the old handyman "George" still resides in the basement. There have been some who say they have seen "people" of the built-up walls in the basement.
- One woman claims that while using the lady's

restroom she saw a globular structure behind her as she looked in the mirror.

- In Theatre #1, some have said they have been grabbed or had their hair touched and the feeling of heaviness in that area. While in Theatre #2, people have seen shadows walking the aisles, the disembodied sounds of footsteps on the stage.
- Theatre #4 is thought to be the most active. People claim to see or smell smoke, disembodied voices having conversations or the sounds of footsteps. People have seen shadows and the sounds of walking in the projector room, heard theater seats go down as if someone sat down, and even apparitions have been seen in Theatre #4.



Berkeley Plantation's history begins in 1619 when settlers observed the first official Thanksgiving in America. Berkeley's 1726 Georgian mansion is the birthplace of Benjamin Harrison V, signer of the Declaration of Independence and three times governor of Virginia. The estate is also the birthplace of William Henry Harrison, ninth president of the United States, and ancestral home of his grandson, Benjamin Harrison, the twenty-third president. During the Civil War, Berkeley was occupied by General George McClellan's Union troops. While at Berkeley, General Daniel Butterfield composed the familiar tune "Taps," first played by his bugler, O.W. Norton. John Jamieson, a drummer boy with McClellan's forces, returned to Berkeley in 1907 and purchased the house and 1400

The Grand Victorian Inn dates back to 1885, when it was owned by the Renfro family and was used as a hotel for Mammoth Cave tourists. Back then, tourists would come in on the railroad, which sits right in front of the bed and breakfast and take stagecoaches to Mammoth Cave. History of The Mentz Hotel stretches back to just after The War Between the States. Mr. Mentz was the train station master for Mammoth Cave Railroad Co. from 1853, taking visitors to Mammoth Cave on four passenger cars. In 1885, Mr. Mentz and Mr. Renfro created The Mentz Hotel which unfortunately burned down in 1903. In 1905, the Renfro Hotel became the Mentz Hotel and then later on it became the Fishback Hotel. From 1946 to 1952, the building became the Baulch Junior School for Boys and then was home to a nursing home for six years before it became a private home. The Carroll's bought The Grand Victorian Inn in 2015 and have lovingly restored it back to its glory days! Beside the Grand Victorian is Bell's Tavern ruins. Revolutionary war veteran Colonel William Bell built an inn beside the highway. It grew into the 19th century "Bell's Tavern". The inn became a hotspot for the shabby the well-heeled alike. Built during the mid-19th century, the tavern was gutted by fire just prior to the Civil War. Though the family intended rebuild it out of stone, the outbreak of war prevented them from completing the project. Today, massive stone walls and arched windows are overgrown with ivy.



John McInTeer was born in Ireland and as a young unsupervised boy in 1827, he traveled to the United States. He settled first in Philadelphia and then Indiana, where he learned the trade of harness making. Hearing of the opportunities existing in the west, he moved to Kansas in the early 1860s. First setting up home in Doniphan County, John McInTeer started a small shop in Atchison where he manufactured harnesses and saddles. His product became known for their workmanship and he did a great amount of business wagon trains plying the Overland Trails. His Business was so successful that he had to enlarge his facilities and manufacture his product on a large scale. The wealth he accumulated from his business was invested into real estate in Atchison and nearby St. Joseph, MO. He also erected number of business blocks in Atchison. The McInTeer Villa is one of Atchison's most unique residencies. Built in 1889-1890 for business pioneer

John McInteer the impressive brick residence was constructed at an estimated cost of \$14,000. The architect has not been identified. However, the builder was Owen E. Seip, a long time Atchison contractor. Mr. McInteer first wife Alice, died in 1892. He married his second wife, Anna Conlon, a widow with three sons in 1895. After Mr. McInteer's death in 1902, Anna continued living in the home until her death in 1916. During her ownership, the house was home to large numbers of the Conlon relatives which included many children. From 1916-1925 her brother Judge Charles J. Conlon, a prominent lawyer and his family made it their home. For the next twenty-five years it was a rooming house and then in 1952, the McInteer Villa was purchased by Ms. Isobel Altus, a retired professional violinist and eccentric according to her Atchison neighbors. She lacked the financial resources to follow through on her desire to restore the house and in 1969, shortly before her death sold it George Gerady who had started to rehabilitate it. The McInteer Villa is still one of the most unusual and picturesque houses built in Atchison today.

### THE PARANORMAL CLAIMS:

Many have seen lights turning on and off in the tower.... there is no electricity up there. People have seen figures in the windows when no one was home. A speaker was thrown off the counter and boxes have been seen to move. The rocking chair that "Goldie" died in has been known to rock back and forth on its own. Sounds of slamming doors throughout the night. Footstep walking down the hallway on the second floor have been heard throughout the night. Some feel uneasy on the second floor, as if they are being watched. Items tend to move from one location to another, doorknobs creaking, lights turning on and off, and dramatic temperature

And nine documented deaths (natural deaths) and one suicide (Charles Donovan 10-10-1922) are documented to have occurred at the 1889 McInteer Villa.

The haunted house in Hinsdale, NY is perhaps the most famous haunted house in the area. It has all of the elements of a good ghost story. A mysterious history, strange sightings, unexplainable events, and even an exorcism! The house was built in 1853, with land records dating back to the 1700's. With the land being on top of a hill and containing a water source, it is a perfect place for Native Americans to want to live. In fact, native artifacts have been discovered in the ground when doing renovations. Clara and Phil Dandy, along with their children, began living in the house in the early 1970s. During their time there, they were visited by many spirits. A priest from St. Bonaventure University was at the house more than once to perform an exorcism which worked for a while but as time went by the Dandy family lost the battle and ended up leaving the house for good. As the years passed, other families have tried to

live in the home.... none of them stayed for long. Nowadays, Daniel Klaes is the owner of the infamous Hinsdale House and allows paranormal groups to investigate the property in hopes of discovering the mystery behind the spirits who haunt this home.

The Masonic Temple in Salina, Kansas is a monumental Classical Revival-style building completed in 1927. It was listed on the National Register of Historic Places in 2000. It is 125 by 170 feet and is built of reinforced concrete. It is clad in limestone and marble. It was designed by Oklahoma City architect William T. Schmitt. Two years into its construction, the structure collapsed, and Schmitt was replaced by Isaac L. Zerbe of the firm Wilmarth & Zerbe, and "apparently the contractor freely consulted both plans in completing the construction." Famed musician John Phillip Sousa played during the dedication ceremony in 1927. The grand lobby of these seven floors, 160,000 square foot building contains marble slabs, split to reflect angel



wings and the front doors are made of bronze. And if that didn't make "The Temple" intimidating enough, there are 122 hand-hammered copper gargoyles surrounding the building. As the years gone by, The Temple still remains as the most iconic building in Salina. However, some people who have walked inside The Temple never left. the two most famous, or infamous residents of the building are "Top Hat Man" and "Zachary". Top Hat Man is sometimes seen and heard in the upper balconies of the theatre, while the mischievous Zachary, who is believed to be a 5-year-old boy, has been known to untie and sometimes even cut shoelaces. There have been numerous unexplained happenings inside of the building. Things like doors opening and closing, voices and singing can be heard, and some have heard what appears to be the sound of an old-time AM radio frequency. 
